
Navigation Instructions

Press **F11** to view this lesson in full screen.




This module also has a **Table of Contents**, or **TOC**, to jump to different sections of the lesson. You can open and close it with either:


- the arrow in the top left corner of the screen,

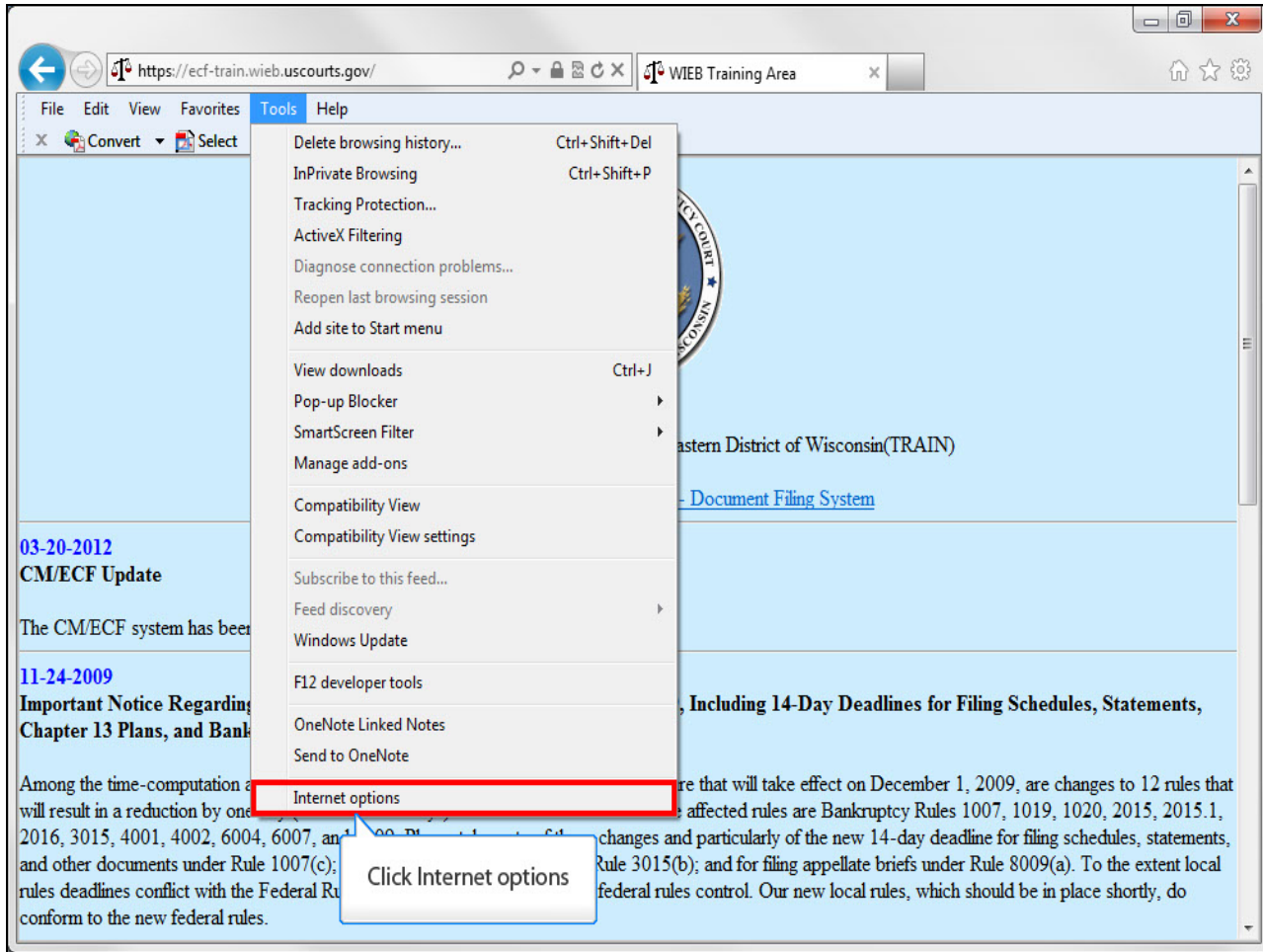

In the General tab, click the Delete button under the Browsing History section.

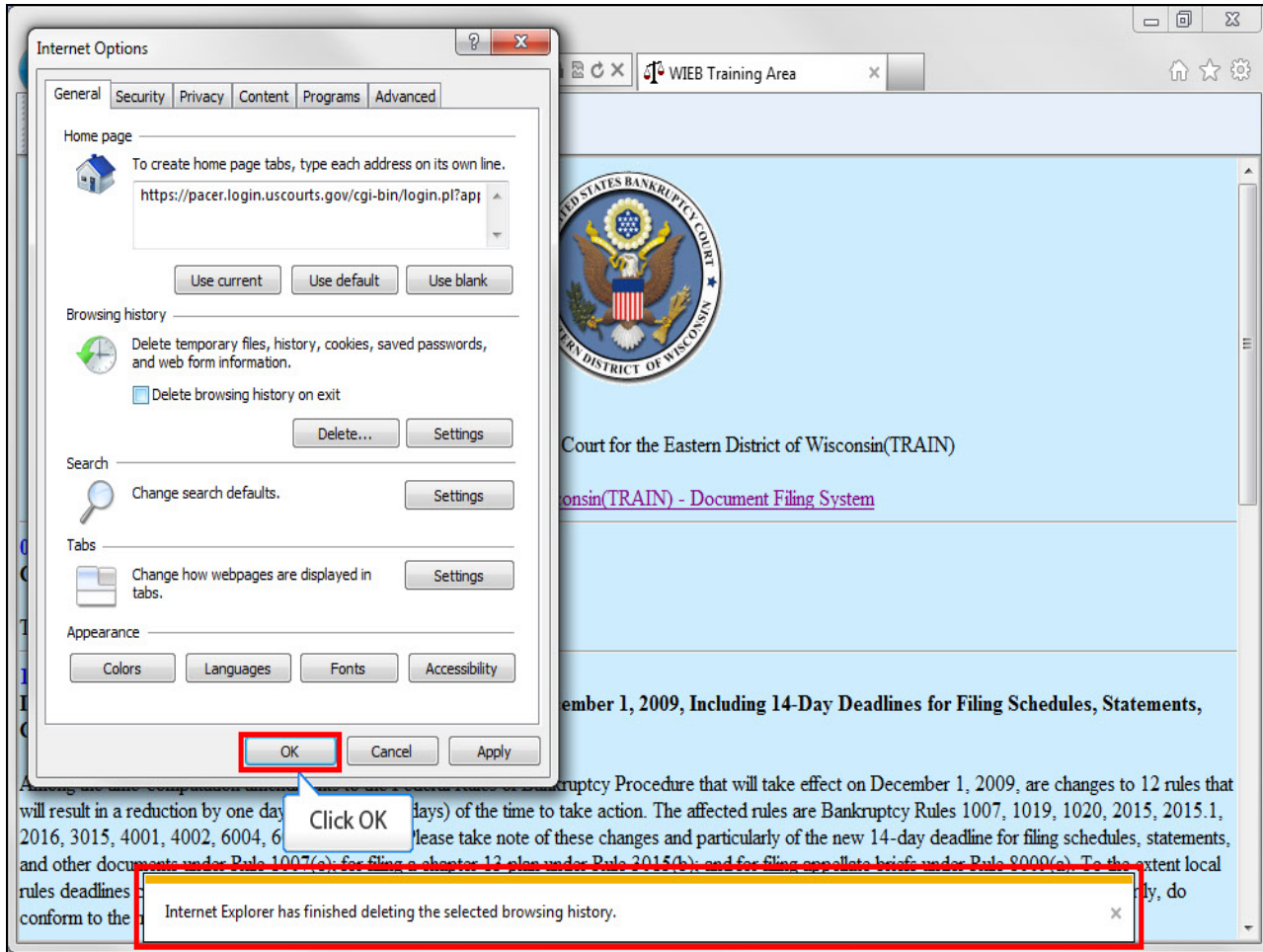

The Delete Browsing History window opens. At a minimum, be sure the box next to Temporary Internet files is checked. Verify with your IT department which other options should be checked. Then click Delete.


