**ORDER APPROVING STIPULATION AND AUTHORIZING
WITHDRAWAL OF TRUSTEE'S AFFIDAVIT OF DEFAULT**

The Court has reviewed the stipulation filed _____ between the Debtor and the Chapter 13 Trustee. The Debtor acknowledges having defaulted under the terms of the settlement of the Trustee's Motion to Dismiss. The Trustee acknowledges that the Debtor has cured the default [or that extraordinary circumstances exist, permitting the Trustee to withdraw the Affidavit of Default]. Accordingly, pursuant to the stipulation,

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED: the Trustee is authorized to withdraw the Affidavit of Default; entry of this Order serves as notice of the withdrawal, and no further action on the Trustee's part is required.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: the withdrawal of the Affidavit of Default is without prejudice to the Trustee filing another Affidavit or Motion to Dismiss, as appropriate, for any future defaults.

If appropriate: [IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: the "doomsday period" is extended through and including _____. Should the Debtor fail to mail the equivalent of one monthly payment through and including _____, the Trustee may submit an Affidavit of Default and a proposed Order Dismissing Case.]
