[Optional] IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: to the extent Bankruptcy Rule 3002.1 applies, the Movant is no longer required to file or provide the notices required by that Rule.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: all other relief requested in the motion is denied.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: this Order is effective immediately and is not stayed for 14 days pursuant to Bankruptcy Rule 4001(a)(4).
